EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2018-13

**RELATIVE TO ACTIVATING THE GUAM NATIONAL GUARD AND
AUTHORIZING OVERTIME IN ORDER TO PROVIDE SERVICES
SUPPORTING THE PRE-LANDFALL PREPARATIONS AND SUBSEQUENT
AFTERMATH RECOVERY EFFORTS ARISING FROM TROPICAL STORM
MANGKHUT AND ITS CONTINUING DEVELOPMENT INTO A
CATASTROPHIC TYPHOON**

WHEREAS, Guam has been advised by the National Weather Service, Guam Weather Forecast Office (NWS) that as of 6:00 a.m., Saturday, September 8, 2018, Tropical Depression 26W has been upgraded to Tropical Storm Mangkhut; and

WHEREAS, the NWS forecasts that Tropical Storm Mangkhut will continue to intensify as it moves westward towards Guam and that it could become a Category 5 typhoon by the time it reaches Guam late Tuesday or early Wednesday; and

WHEREAS, a Category 5 Typhoon is a "Devastating Typhoon" with maximum sustained winds of 157-194 mph and peak gusts of 199-264 mph. According to the NWS, "a Category 5 typhoon has the ability to be life-threatening to those that do not prepare in advance"; and

WHEREAS, as declared by Executive Order No. 2018-12, a current state of emergency exists relative to securing the island and the community from the approaching storm; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Operations Center at the Office of Civil Defense has been established and is preparing for full activation to duty; and



WHEREAS, the services of the Guam National Guard are needed to assist the local government, particularly the Department of Public Works, the Department of Education, the Department of Public Health and Social Services, the Guam Police Department and the Guam Fire Department, along with other government of Guam departments and agencies; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDDIE BAZA CALVO, Governor of Guam, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act and laws of Guam, do hereby order and direct as follows:


1. **Activation of the Guam National Guard and Duties.** The Guam National Guard is hereby activated beginning at 10:00 a.m., September 9, 2018, for at least ten (10) days until September 19, 2018, unless extended by subsequent executive order. The activation is to include Army and Air elements. The Adjutant General or his designee, with the approval of the Governor, shall select appropriate personnel from any units needed to perform the missions necessary to respond to any enhanced security requirements that may arise.

The activated units or members are directed to render all necessary assistance in providing services relative responding to the pre-landfall preparations and any subsequent aftermath caused by the passage of Tropical Storm/Typhoon Mangkhut. The Guam National Guard military commanders will take the measure or perform all those activities necessary to prevent, forestall, or combat the effects of the emergency situation. Accomplishment of the above stated missions and the command and control of the command units are the sole responsibility of the Guam National Guard military commander subject to the statutory control of the Governor as Commander-in-Chief.



2. **Authorization for Overtime.** Authorization is given for the payment of overtime, both for exempt and non-exempt Government of Guam and National Guard employees, to work in excess of forty (40) hours a week in order to mitigate and respond to the effects of Tropical Storm/Typhoon Mangkhut throughout Guam. The GHS/OCD Administrator is authorized to determine the eligibility of overtime expenditures resulting from work performed by the government agencies, and the approval shall be obtained prior to incurring any overtime or other expenses. The failure to obtain such prior approval shall be grounds for denying reimbursement.
3. **Documentation of Expenses.** All departments and agencies are instructed to keep appropriate documentation on all emergency expenses authorized by this Executive Order for inspection by the Executive and Legislative Branches and by the Public Auditor of Guam, and in anticipation of federal disaster assistance approval by the President of the United States to be administered by FEMA.
4. **Construction with E.O. No. 2018-12.** This Executive Order shall be construed and applied in conjunction and harmony with Executive Order No. 2018-12.
